Fee Waiver Eligibility: Fee waivers are available for the following types of activities and whose use does not exclude "in season" athletic league play, THPRD recreation or educational programming, or events. The following permits are eligible for reduction of usage fees.

- News Production, Cable Access, Public Service Announcements.
- Documentary/Advertising/Marketing for the promotion of Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District, City of Beaverton, Metro or the State of Oregon.
- Student Film for class projects or non-commercial student productions.

Fee waivers are also available to groups who will have 10 or fewer people within the park and whose use does not exclude THPRD recreation/educational programming or events.

Release and Indemnity Agreement: In consideration of this permit issued by Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District (THPRD) for the purpose of photographing in the public areas - the applicant, sponsor, legal representatives and assigns, shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless THPRD, its officers, elected officials, volunteers, agents and employees against all liability loss or expenses, including attorney fees, and against all claims or actions based upon or arising out of damage or injury (including death) to persons, animals or property caused by any negligence on the part of the applicant, sponsor, its agents or employees. The applicant/permit holder must provide and maintain liability insurance in the amount of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit for injury or death to more than one person in any one occurrence, property damage including loss of use, and \$2,000,000 general aggregate coverage. A certificate of insurance and additional insured endorsement naming Tualatin Hills Park & Recreation District, its officers, agents, employees and volunteers as an additional insured must be received prior to issuance of the permit.
