IV. Agenda Items

Grounds Report - Allan Wells

- Allan Wells reported that the geraniums that were thinned out of the beds have been set aside in the green house for the Advisory Committee plant sale.
- Aloha Garden Club has been working in the green house and herb garden.
- Head Gardner continues to map critical shut offs for utilities.

Superintendent's Report - Lisa

 \$10,000 has been budgeted for an engineering consultant to draw plans for restoration of the foundation on the JQAY house. Lisa has the name of a consultant and will set up a meeting with Lisa, Lynda and consultant to discuss.

Center Supervisor Report - Lynda

- The 37th annual Painter's Showcase was held in October at the stable. Painter's Showcase group were very happy with the show and resulting sales. Attendance was good.
- The annual Spooktacular children's event was held the day before Halloween. Again, attendance was good; the weather was mild with rain holding off until late in the day. New games were added this year. The pumpkin patch was a big hit with two tractors providing hay rides to the pumpkin patch.

- Staff will begin Holiday decorating in the stable and main house this week. All décor will be in place by November 27.
- Staff is preparing for Holiday Teas on December 4th & 7th.

New Business: Committee Reports

Herb Garden:

- Willie has been doing research on signs for the Herb Garden. Both the interpretive signs and the
 identification signs need some changes. Willie suggested that the Committee update those identification
 signs that need it. Bill O'Brien suggested that we may be able to move or add plants in places so that we
 don't have to re-do all of the signs. Allan Wells asked that the Committee think about one large interpretive
 sign that can be utilized by visual readers as well as Braille reader.
- Motion: Willie Willworth moved that the Committee replace the identification signs that needed updating with a long range goal to upgrade the interpretive sign.
