## Summer Camp Deposits and Balances

A \$25 deposit is required for each participant, for weeks 2 through 11, at the time of registration. Full balances are due for week 1 at the time of registration. Deposit is non-refundable. However, it may be transferred to other THPRD programs prior to June 2. **Please note: After June 2, deposits will no longer be transferable.** A camp balance will be refundable or transferable only if requested at least two weeks prior to the start of the week you are requesting to drop. All camp balances will be due by 5 pm on the Monday two weeks prior to the start date of each camp week.
