No sharp, dangerous items that could hurt someone will be allowed. One-pitch rules apply with the exception that all players must wear a costume. NSA softball approved gear must be used (bats, shoes/cleats, gloves). Also, don't wear headgear that would impair vision.

## Teams will be placed into divisions according to level requested, number of teams applying, etc.

Round Robin Format, each team is guaranteed 4 games (if tournament fills) )
*If fewer teams apply, the tournament will be adjusted (e.g. combining teams into one division)

## HALLOWEEN ONE-PITCH SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

The following are some of the tournament rules that will be enforced, along with the 2014 Official NSA rules, throughout the tournament. The complete list of rules will be emailed along with the game schedule on Sept. $26{ }^{\text {th }}$.

All players must be listed with the Tournament Director before allowed to play.
$>$ The home team is the official scorekeeper.
$>$ A team may have a minimum of 8 players ( 4 men $/ 4$ women) to start or continue a game. The team must have an equal number of men and women on the field at all times. Positioning on the field is at the discretion of each team.
$>$ Teams can bat the line-up, bat the roster or bat the WHEEL.
$>$ All players are required to be dressed in a costume unrelated to softball or baseball. NO COSTUME, NO PLAY!! No sharp, dangerous items that could hurt someone will be allowed. Headwear should not impair vision.
$\Rightarrow$ All games will have a time limit, with no new innings to start after this time. All ties will be played out in "extra-inning" play until a winner is declared.
> A chalk line will be marked in the outfield at 180 feet from home plate. No outfielder may cross the line, toward the infield, until the ball is hit by either a male or female batter.
$>$ A 10 run rule will be enforced after 5 complete innings.
$>$ There will be a 6 run limit per inning except the last inning, which will be unlimited.
$>$ NSA substitution rules or batting the roster shall apply.
$>$ COURTESY RUNNER - Runner must be designated at the pre-game conference with the umpire. Batter must make it to first base. Courtesy runner must be last out and in coed, the last out of the same gender.
$>$ Each batter receives one pitch, in effect assumes a 3-2 count; opposing pitchers will pitch one pitch to the batter. Umpire will call that pitch a ball, strike, or foul ball.
$>$ All females must bat. Exception: If a male batter is intentionally walked (verbal request only) the female batter has her choice of walking or hitting.
$\rightarrow$ Progressive home run rule will be used for all over-the-fence hits. Progressive means that no team may be more than one home run ahead of the other team. A dead ball single will be the penalty for any home run hits that puts a team 2 ahead of their opponent.
$>$ No jewelry may be worn during the game unless it is part of the costume. Dangerous items will not be allowed. NOTE: Any exposed metal may be considered legal if covered by soft material and taped. Medical tags are acceptable if covered with clear tape and taped to the body.
$>$ Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the THPRD Softball Complex.
$>$ Medical insurance will not be supplied by Tualatin Hills Park \& Recreation District or the Tualatin Hills Softball Association.
