My Recommendation:

Stainless


- Tramontina 12 piece set from Costco (\$200)
- · Great return policy
- Stainless lids are oven safe to higher temp (generally 500 vs ~350 degrees)
- Solid unit construction (compared to Kitchenaid set)



My Recommendation:

Nonstick

- Carote 8 inch pan from Amazon (\$21)
- Saves \$20-30 compared to the larger version
- Nonstick is generally only necessary for things like eggs, which don't require a large pan



James suggested to put a price cap at \$300 based on the recommendation for the Cookware and nonstick pan

- 2. Induction cooktop
 - 1. Robert mentioned that Miele is a German brand and well known for their high quality products
 - Frigidaire model was rejected by the committee and the reason is that there is not much feedback/information available on the quality of the product
 - Team consensually voted for Miele product (and this is the product that was installed last year and the feedback have been very positive as well)
- 3. Downdraft ventilation system
 - 1. Budget cap: \$2750
 - 2. Cameron will send out the selected cooktop details and the list of downdraft ventilations systems to the tech/HVAC team
 - Will solicit feedback from the tech team on compatibility between the ventilation system and Miele cooktop
 - 2. Cameron will share the update over email and before next meeting, team can share their inputs
